*All FAST courses will be nested. Masters/Excellent, Open and Novice will walk together and then run consecutively.

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of each class.

Trial Site

Obstacles will conform to current AKC Agility Regulations. Electronic Timers will be used at these trials.

Warm up/practice jump: Regulation agility jump will be set up in designated area, if space allows.

Crates may be left overnight. Neither Competitive Edge nor PCA will be responsible for personal articles left at the site. No grooming is allowed in the building. No dogs may be left overnight.

Crating will be tight. Please be prepared to stack crates and condense the space you use. No x-pens or “living room” set ups will be allowed. Chairs may only be allowed in designated areas, depending on entry numbers.

Directions

FROM SOUTH: From I-65N take KY-1747 (exit 125, Fern Valley Rd). Go approx. 3.6 miles, turn left onto Shepherdsville Rd, KY-2052. Go another 1.9 miles and **CEA** will be on your left.

FROM NORTH: From I-65S take I-264E (exit 131A Watterson Expr.), take KY-1703S (Exit 15 Newburgh Rd), Turn left on Indian Trail, turn right onto Shepherdsville Rd. **CEA** will be on your right.

FROM EAST: From 64W, take US-31E/US-150 (Exit 16 Bardstown Rd.), go left at the fork, follow Bardstown Rd S, right onto Hikes Ln, left onto KY- 2052 Shepherdsville Rd. **CEA** will be on your right.

FROM WEST: From 64E, take I-264E to (Exit 15 Newburgh Rd), Turn left on Indian Trail, turn right onto Shepherdsville Rd. **CEA** will be on your right.

Eligible Dogs

This trial is open to Papillons only all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Exceptions are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, and dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partner may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

Jump Height Card Process

There is a new section in the middle of the entry form to designate whether your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Entry Fees

Fee for first and second class entry per day: \$22 per run, \$20 2nd run fee for additional classes per day: \$18 per run. Checks should be made out to **PCA**. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

Please note, express mail deliveries should contain a signature allowing them to be left at the trial secretary's address without recipient's signature. Maximum of 10 dogs are allowed in each envelope. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the Agreement and Rules. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Confirmations

For those who provide an e-mail address entry received confirmations will be sent as entries are received. Entry accepted confirmations will be sent after the draw. Please be sure to have your e-mail address printed clearly on entry form. After closing date final confirmation and judging schedule will be sent via e-mail. Confirmation via the postal service will only occur if you enclose a self-addressed, stamped postcard with your entry. Judging schedule, worker schedule and exhibitor information will also be available on the trial secretary website, www.louleesshelties.com after closing.

Refunds

No refunds for overpayment of \$10.00 or less. No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. A refund of 100% of the entry fees will be given for any reason if the request is received prior to closing by the Trial Secretary in writing or e-mail. After closing and prior to the trial starting, entry fees (less \$6/per run. for AKC and administrative fees) will be refunded for injured dogs, injured handlers, and bitches in season. The Trial Committee may require a doctor/vet's letter for injuries. Refund requests received after the start of the Trial will not be given for any reason.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show site by the Trial Committee. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made. Minor children must be supervised at all times. Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the show site by the Trial Committee.
- Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars, head halter, and special training collars are prohibited on the trial grounds. This includes bark collars.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or designated agility warm-up area. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. Please help us keep this site clean future use. Hotels/motels are considered to be part of the show environs.
- **AVMA Statement:** Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs have appropriate vaccinations and are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases.

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run

and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

Special awards will be given to the dog/handler team earning a Double Q in Standard (Preferred) and Jumpers with Weaves (Preferred) with the highest combined YPS (yards per second). If there is no Double Q, the dog with the highest YPS will earn the award. In the case of a tie, the dog with the highest YPS in Standard (Preferred) will be the winner.

Any dog/handler teams eligible for high scoring breed champion, Phalène, or junior handler must sign up by 10:30 am on the day of each trial.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
